After c, the letters that make the ee sound are the other way around: e comes before i. Share with your child that there are a number of exceptions to the rule. These exceptions just need to be learned. Encourage your child to use speech marks for spoken words and not to use them for unspoken words. Also teach them rules to include punctuation mark before closing the speech marks Eg: In a direct speech sentence, we would narrate Iggy's spoken words like this: "I bid you farewell Earthlings!" shouted Iggy from his spaceship. Topic: Taking Responsibility for Oneself and Others

Explanation text

To read and analyze explanatory texts to identify key features.

To distinguish between explanatory texts, reports and recounts while recognizing that an information book might contain examples of all these forms of text.

Share real-life examples of people who cause destruction to mankind due to ambition. Talk about World War.

Encourage your child to read Macbeth and discuss the roles of Macbeth and Lady Macbeth. The way Lady Macbeth provoked Macbeth to do the heinous crime and how he was haunted by his conscience. Discuss and analyse the characters and their actions.

Encourage your child to choose a character and do a role play to emote feelings of the character.

Talk to your child to create an awareness of environmental issues locally and at national and global level.

Talk to your child about the structure and language features of explanation texts to describe the phenomena and processes that take place in nature and everyday life.

Share with your child a few samples of different text for example, a news report, a narrative and explanation text. Now work in pair and analyse the similarities and differences between these text- language and text features. Then discuss the formal language used in the news report and the explanation text.

To summarize the explanation text by presenting it in the form of flow charts or cyclical diagrams as appropriate.

Share examples of explanation texts to identify key features: the purpose, structure, language features and presentational features.

Encourage your child to highlight the technical words and language features to summarise the points in the explanation text thereby helping them to present it in the form of a flowchart or mind map. Now encourage your child to write an explanation text using key features.

Talk to your child about what it means to be responsible for their own work, for eg, simple tasks like ensuring they are ready for the school day with the necessary books and stationery in their bag. Do they take responsibility to do their own tasks without reminders from parents and teachers?

Encourage your child to assume responsibility as the next step for home tasks as well, for eg, helping in household chores.


