Write the word in the first column, and have your child trace the letters. Next have your child copy the word by looking at what he /she's just written. Finally, have your child fold (and hide) the first two columns and recall the spelling of the word independently. Examples for 'ay' words – stay, crayon; 'ai' words- paid, rain,; 'oi' words- soil, coin; 'oy' words- joy, annoy. Read along with your child and emphasize on the use of capital letters and full stops. Talk about capital letters and full stops. Show simple sentences from various books/magazines/newspapers to make him/her understand it better. Now write simple sentences on sentence strips and encourage your child to punctuate it. Check your writing! 



UAE Social Studies

 To sequence events using time words e.g. (today, yesterday, last night, etc.)



 To identify and explore other cultures with different languages, food, clothing, etc.



Share with your child the importance of events e.g. (celebrating a birthday, festival, graduating from FS2 to Year 1, etc.) using time words e.g. (today, yesterday, last night, etc.)

Encourage your child to sequence any event they loved to be a part of and celebrated in the UAE using, time words.

Talk to your child about the different languages spoken in the UAE and the different food and clothes available here from different countries and cultures.

Share with your child your culture, your languages, food, clothing, etc. of your native country. Also share the different types of food people eat and clothes people wear depending on the climatic conditions of where they live.

Encourage your child to draw and make a list of the different types of food and clothes of your country and the special occasions they wear them.

Talk to your child about the meaning of culture. **Share** that different countries have got different cultures.
