#### Grammar:

• To explore varied sentence structures with synonyms and antonyms.

For example: We had bread, jam, eggs, oats and milk for breakfast.

**Encourage** your child to look at commas used in stories.

**Discuss** how commas are used to separate words or lists in sentences.

**Encourage** your child to highlight the speech marks and note how they are written at the beginning and the end of sentences.

**Share** with your child that an adjective can be used to make comparisons.

For example:

James is **tall** 

His sister Jill is **taller** than him.

Their dad is the **tallest** in the family.

The words **tall, taller and tallest** are the degrees of comparison of the adjective -tall.






