



- Encourage your child to understand and use approximate equivalences between metric units and common imperial units such liters and millilitres have e.g. 2 L of water. I need to divide it into 5 smaller jugs equally. How much water in ml will be in each of the five small jugs?
- Child would need to know that 2 liters is the same as 2000ml. They would then need to divide 2000 by 5 to make 400ml.
