Aim High Summer Holiday Programme

In the Aim High Summer Programme, we have included activities that add an artistic or creative element to the learning. We are also aligning our activities this year with the **Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs)** of health and well-being. These activities will promote research, enquiry, critical and analytical thinking, design thinking and problem solving. STREAM learning will happen naturally and students will develop **High Performance Learning Skills** as they do the designated activities; engage in discussions with friends and family members; establish links or connections with real life; examine outcomes; make corrections or further modification; research; play, explore and try new things.

The activities designed in the programme require students to use Science, Technology, Reading, Engineering, Arts and Mathematics as access points for guiding student inquiry, dialogue, rich experiential learning, research and critical thinking.

In Science, students will research, evaluate and devise strategies related to clean water and sanitation and then design a project (app/ presentation/ 3D model) that contributes to raising awareness on Sustainable Development Goal 6. In Math they will collect information, compare and use critical thinking skills to interpret the findings. In English the students will focus on reading, researching and analysing the impact of clean water and sanitation. Art and Technology is integrated in all the activities specially in the core subjects which will unleash their creative skills as they present their work.

All students must submit the tasks to their respective teachers. All work samples submitted must be well presented, clear and with quality work.

Please note that this project is to keep students engaged in learning during summers hence the task should be well paced and not completed in haste.

Topic: SDG Goal 6, Clean water and sanitation

Outcome: To achieve universal and equitable access to safe and affordable drinking water, sanitation and hygiene.

Goal 6 of the Sustainable Development Goals is all about making sure everyone has clean water and good sanitation.



Imagine a big world where lots of people live. Now, think about how important water is for all of them. Water is not only for drinking but also for washing, cooking and growing food. So, Goal 6 is like a promise from all the countries to make sure that every person, especially kids like you have clean and safe water to drink.



But it is not about having water. It is also about keeping it clean. Sometimes, water can get dirty from things like trash or germs and that's not good for anyone. So, Goal 6 also means making sure the water stays clean and healthy for everyone to use.

Now, let's talk about sanitation. Sanitation is a fancy word for having clean bathrooms and places to wash your hands, it is super important because it helps keep people healthy. So, SDG 6 is about making sure that everyone has access to good toilets and places to wash their hands properly. When we achieve SDG 6, it means that kids and families all around the world can drink clean water, use clean bathrooms and stay healthy. When everyone is healthy and has clean water, it helps make the world a better place for everyone to dwell!

English: Now it is time to apply the information collected and engage in one of the activities below. Be creative and think outside the box as you design your project. Choose any one activity that inspires you.

<p>Activity 3: Water Quest: Clean Water and Sanitation Adventure</p>	

Objective: Design a board game where players solve challenges to collect clean water tokens and sanitation points.

Instructions: Design the Game Board:

Create a board representing different regions (desert, forest, urban, rural), each with unique water and sanitation challenges. Use a large piece of cardboard or poster board, drawing paths and spaces for players to land on.



Create Tokens and Pieces:

Design player tokens (e.g., water droplets, sanitation workers) using clay, 3D printing, or recycled materials. Make clean water tokens and sanitation points.

Develop Game Cards:

Create challenge cards with tasks like building a water filtration system or organizing a community clean-up. Create reward cards offering tokens or points for

completing challenges.

Write the Rulebook: Explain how to play the game, including moving around the board, drawing cards, earning tokens and points, and winning. Focus on teamwork and problem-solving.

Play the Game: Draw challenge cards and complete tasks specific to each region. The game ends when a player reaches the final destination. The player with the cleanest water tokens and sanitation points wins.

Reflect on Learning:

Share what you learned about clean water and sanitation solutions.

This project will help students understand water filtration, pollution prevention, and sanitation systems while enhancing their skills in science, technology, engineering, art, and mathematics.

Humanities- Explore and be innovative designers. Attempt any two activities of your choice.

Activity 1: Design an Anglo-Saxon Village: Water and Sanitation in Action

Step 1: Build a model of an Anglo-Saxon village. Include features such as wells, streams, and sanitation facilities.

Step 2: Apply your **innovative skills** to show how water would flow through the village and how waste could be managed.

Activity 2: Exploring Ancient Techniques: Digital Simulations of Anglo-Saxon Water Purification

Step 1: Use online simulations and interactive tools to show how water purification works.

Step 2: Relate these simulations back to the techniques that might have been used or could have been used by the Anglo-Saxons.

Activity 3: Interactive Maps

Create interactive maps of North America's water resources, showing areas of clean and contaminated water.

Activity 4: Clean Future: Innovations in Water and Sanitation Transform North America

Write a futuristic story set in North America where new technologies have solved many of the water and sanitation issues. Describe how these techniques have improved life for everyone.

ICT, Mathematics and Science- Enquire, Investigate, Analyze and Present-

Activity- Water Filtration

Research and talk to your child about the significance of Clean water and sanitation.

Focus on –

- What is the cause of water pollution?
- How does poor sanitation affect communities?
- What are some challenges people face in accessing clean water around the world?

Students will create simple water filters using materials like sand, gravel, twigs and charcoal etc. They will measure the volume of water before and after filtration and calculate the efficiency. The 3-D model to be presented in the class along explaining how it works. The explanation can be pre-recorded and a video can be shared or it can be presented verbally or through any ICT tool.

Steps:

1. Introduction

- Explain filtration and the experiment's purpose.
- Write the importance of clean water and safety precautions.

2. Prepare Filters

- Cut plastic bottles in half and place upside down.
- Layer materials: coffee filter or cheesecloth, charcoal, sand, and gravel.

3. Prepare Dirty Water

- Mix water with soil or contaminants.
- Measure a specific volume (e.g., 500 ml).

4. Filtration Process

- Pour dirty water into the filter.
- Collect filtered water in a beaker.

5. Measure and Record Data

- Measure the volume of filtered water.
- Record initial and final volumes in a tabular form for different types of filters used.

Types of filter	Volume of dirty water before filtration	Volume of clean water collected after filtration	Efficiency

****Calculate Efficiency: ****

- Use the formula:

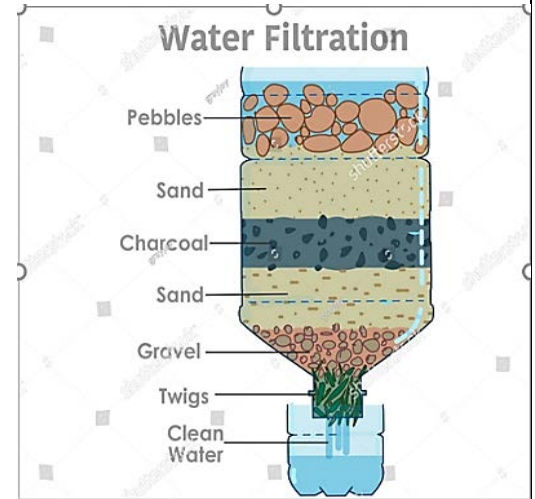
$$\text{Efficiency}(\%) = \left(\frac{\text{Volume of filtered water}}{\text{Volume of dirty water}} \right) \times 100$$

6. Analysis

- Compare the efficiency of different types of filters tested/used.
- Explain why some materials worked better as filter.

7. Conclusion:

- Summarize findings on filtration effectiveness.

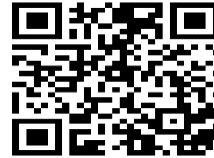
