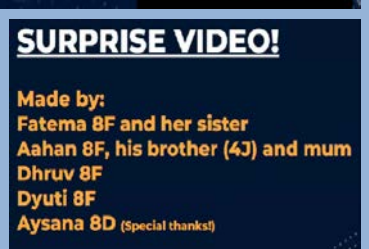
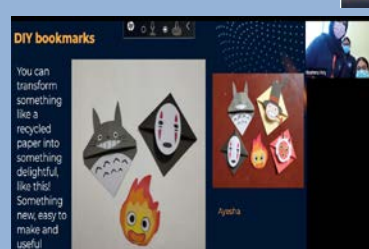
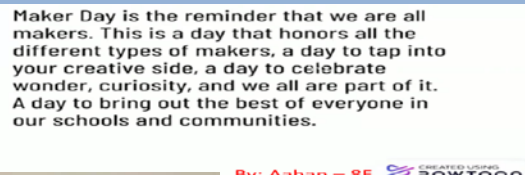
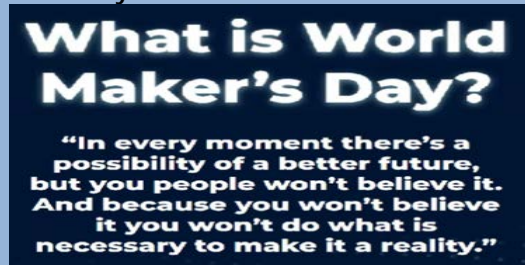
Aims & Objectives:
