Title: Connecting minds

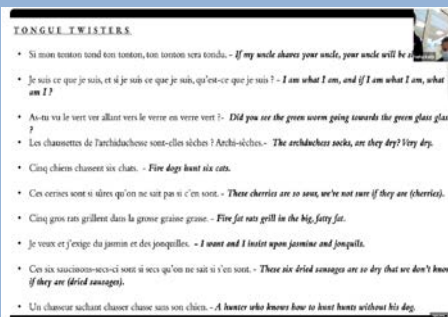
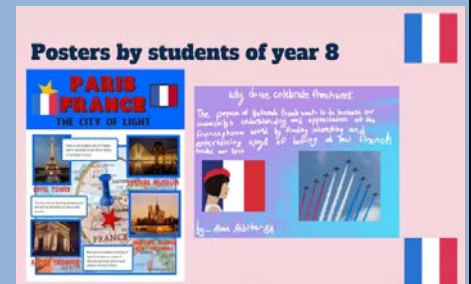
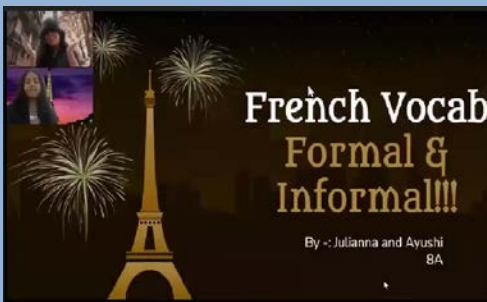
