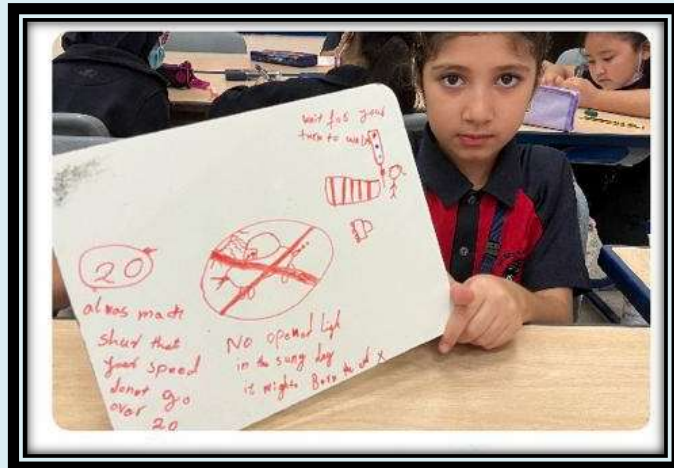
Aims & Objectives: To evaluate and assess the importance of road safety and following the safety rules.
