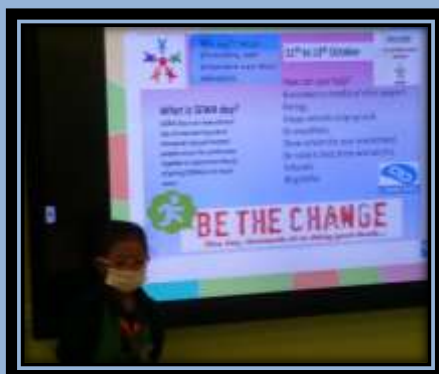
Title: SEWA Day- Year 4
