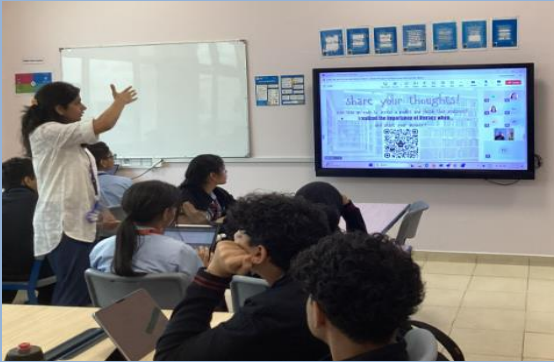
Title: International Literacy Day

Presenters / Conductors: Students of 10B

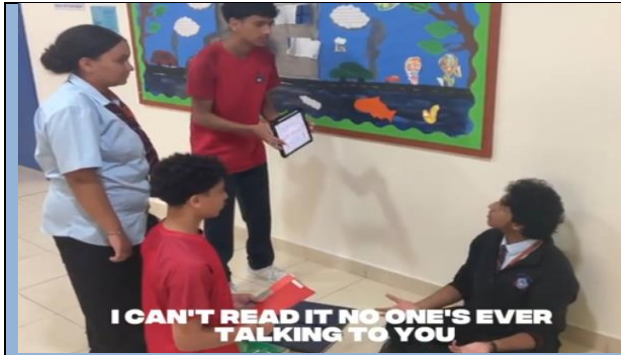
Aims & Objective: To raise awareness among students about the value of literacy in personal growth and societal development.
