

Use a small booklet to write synonyms of a word. Remind your child to replace common words with the new words.


**Verbs:** Give your child a time limit to act out a certain verb. To get more practice within context, tell the guessers that they have to make a sentence using the verb that is being acted out.

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
**Encourage** your child **to** give you instructions on how to play his/her favourite game.
