

For example:

Tom's favourite fruits are bananas, blueberries, strawberries and kiwis. The dragon had long, sharp claws. A hot dog, a type of sausage, is often served in a long bread bun.

Encourage your child while reading a story to highlight punctuation marks including commas.

Compound nouns:

Tell your child that a compound noun is a <u>noun</u> made from at least two words.

Encourage your child to find the two words in a Compound noun.

Example: Toothpaste: a paste used in cleaning the teeth.

<u>Schoolhouse</u>: a building used as a school.

Breadbasket: a basket for serving bread.












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- Then cut up some pieces of yellow card and write the following on each: crowd, pack, litter, bunch, swarm, bouquet, forest, shoal.

Encourage your child to describe things around the house with respect to their positions. Encourage them to use interesting and varied vocabulary to describe the position of the things around.

Example: The flowers are in the vase.

I left my shoes under the brown table.

Information Text:

Discuss the characters, their feelings, different settings and the plot of the stories read.

Encourage your child to read different stories and identify the main story elements (characters, settings, beginning, middle and end)
