

Science	 Describe how different habitats provide for the basic needs of different kinds of animals and plants, and how they depend on one another. Analyze the ways animals adapt to their habitats in order to more effectively catch food, stay safe from predators, and care for their young. 	 Talk to your child about the different places where they see animals and plants living. How do plants and animals survive in any habitat (place). Share with your child pictures of different habitats or ask them to use the internet to find out more about different habitats. (Give clues – vegetation – types of trees, animals, climate etc) Think Ask children to think of any other ways in which animals might be dependent on plants? Encourage children to write down all their findings and make a booklet on habitats. Share with children examples of plants and birds co-habiting. Eg. Birds nesting in trees or bushes, squirrels living in trees, owls nesting in holes in trees, butterflies laying their eggs on plants etc. Plants can provide shade and/ or protection from heavy rain as well as shelter from animals. 	<section-header></section-header>
