

Write the word in the first column, and have your child trace the letters. Next have your child copy the word by looking at what he /she's just written. Finally, have your child fold (and hide) the first two columns and recall the spelling of the word independently. Talk about the rules of capitalization. Write a sentence and ask your child to write capital letters wherever required. Remind them that when you write a diary, it's about yourself and hence I is always capital. 		Share a piece of paper with your child and ask them to write 'I' on it.	



Grammar

To build sentences using 'and', 'but' and 'or'.

Text Level

Take turns to talk about something you have done. Have them hold up the 'I' whenever they say it. E.g.: I went to the zoo. I studied very well in school today.

Encourage your child to help you spell and write out the days onto cards with a different colour for the capital letters. Remind them that places and names also start with a capital letter.

Encourage your child to join simple sentences and clauses using, 'and', 'but' and 'or'. Once written, collaboratively check that the sentences make sense.

Talk about the features of recount writing with your child. Write the following sentences on cards. 'I put on my diving suit.' 'Then I jumped into the sea.' 'There I saw a treasure chest.' After that I opened it up.' 'Finally I found lots of gold coins. Display the cards in the wrong order. Read through the sentences and then Encourage your child to put the sentences in the correct order.

Numeracy

<u>Topics based on GAP Analysis Term</u> <u>3:</u>

To estimate, measure and compare weight using uniform, nonstandard units of measurement.

Talk: After shopping in the supermarket, talk to your child about checking the weight labels and ask him/her how to weigh the fruits and vegetables. Ask your child to compare and estimate the weight of items you have purchased. E.g.: Are the apples heavier than the lemons? How many cubes heavy are the apples?

Encourage your child to show the time after taking quarter turn by asking if the time is 12 O'clock what will the time after taking quarter turn where will be the big hand? Ask if the time is half past 4 now, after taking three-quarter turns where will be the big hand? Challenge your child by asking further if we take three



Science

<u>Continued- Seasonal Changes:</u> <u>FALL and WINTER</u>



- To learn about the effects of weather on the people and their surroundings.
- To investigate how seasons change and the length of day varies in different seasons.-FALL and WINTER
- To explore and compare how seasons differ in different parts of the world e.g. Winters in UAE and in UK.

To investigate the different types of shadow – transparent, translucent and opaque.

EXPLORE, RESEARCH and **SHARE** information on how the day's length varies with changes in the seasons.



Take your child out for shopping and **ENCOURAGE** your child to observe the different types of clothes available.(warm clothes e.g. jackets, scarfs, and full boats OR Light clothes e.g. beach clothes T-shirts, shorts, slippers). **SHARE** information when and why we wear different types of clothes in different season. **RESEARCH** information on weather patterns of UAE and how the weather effects the people and their surroundings.

EXPLORE, RESEARCH and **SHARE** information on opaque, translucent and transparent objects.

Show your child different objects and **ENCOURAGE** your child to observe them (e.g. glass, window glass, book, tinted glass etc) **SHARE** information on the type of material. **RESEARCH** information on the type of shadows they make and sort them as transparent, translucent and opaque.
