



**Talk** to your child that that temperature means degree of hotness or coldness of an object. Emphasise that in each case a change is happening, either by adding heat or taking heat away. Share with your child that a thermometer is used to measure the temperature of any object in degrees Celsius which is the standard unit for measuring temperature.

#### <u>Topics based on Gap Analysis from</u> <u>Term 3</u>

Recognise and use whole, half and quarter turns, both clockwise and anti-clockwise; know that a right angle represents a quarter turn.

To write simple fractions for e.g. 1/ of 6=3 or 2/4 of 8=4 and solve problems involving fractions

Encourage your child to play the modified Simon Says game by putting these concepts into action, giving instructions like make a quarter turn clockwise, then make a half turn anti-clockwise, and so on.

Encourage your child to use **fractions wall**. It is a useful tool that helps them to visualise how fractions relate to each other in size. Look at a fraction wall together and ask your child questions related to it, such as: How many halves make up one whole? How many eighths make up one whole?
