Talk: Together with your child research on any topic (animal/landmark) and elicit the special features.

Share: with you child any extra interesting information you have about the topic.

Encourage: Encourage your child to use appropriate vocabulary, time connectives and correct grammatical syntax as this will ensure quality in the writing tasks.

Children will make a shutter-flap foldable. A plain sheet of white paper in landscape position will be used. The ends of the paper will be folded in to make shutters. The students will break apart the compound word and write one part on each flap. They will illustrate each word part, with a picture to go along with the word. Children will rewrite the compound word together at the top of the page. They will also write the definition and draw a picture to go along with the compound word. They can use a dictionary to confirm the meaning or they can be given oral feedback.

Talk to your child about tolerance of differences.

Share your experiences of the encounters you have had with people of different backgrounds and discuss the benefits of 'differences'. Discuss how meeting someone from a different ethnic background helped broaden your understanding or discover a new point of view.

Encourage your child to accept and respect people of different races, religion and cultures.

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
Numeracy





Growing plants:

- Describe how plants need water, light and a suitable temperature to grow and stay healthy.
- Identify conditions needed for successful germination of seeds.
- Explain the process of germination.

Talk:

What do bulbs need to germinate?

SHARE: <u>Germinate</u> means start growing, (seeds and bulbs have enough goodness contained in them to start growing - once they develop their first true leaves, photosynthesis takes over and the plant produces its own food).

Together with your child grow a plant and observe the different parts of the plant it has and **TALK** about the characteristics of plants as MRS GREN.

Share:

Share real life examples in line with these topics.

Carry out simple experiments and investigation to reinforce the same. For example: wrap the ice with different materials and leave for 10 mins: Now encourage your child to suggest to you what can be the AIM of the experiment. Further talk about the RESULTS and CONCLUSION for the experiment. How would you ensure that it was a fair test?

Encourage your child to visit the websites provided to revisit topics done [factors affecting germination.] Ask your child to **share** with you ideas on how to investigate the factors which affect the growth of a plant.
