



Seed dispersal	 Talk to your child the important function of a leaf in a plant. Make them understand that plants make their own food in the leaves and the process is called photosynthesis. Talk to your child about different types of flowers. Ask your child what type of flower he/she likes most and why? Together observe a real flower. Encourage your child to describe the process of photosynthesis through illustration and writing. Encourage your child to describe the flower using his/her senses. 
