	Grammar Apostrophe for Contraction To use apostrophe for contraction.	Firstly explain to your children that two words can sometimes be made into one, by using apostrophes for contraction. Shouldn't = should not Couldn't = could not Wouldn't = would not Ask the children if they know what the words mean and why they have punctuation marks in the middle of them. Elicit ideas and then explain that the punctuation marks are called 'apostrophes'. Tell the children that we can use an apostrophe to show omission. 	<u>Tense</u> : Simple Present To use tenses appropriately to show the timing of the action.	On a piece of paper, write out a funny story, but leave out most of the verbs. Indicate the missing verb with a line. Without revealing the story, ask your child to come up with verbs and fill in the story. Afterwards, read the story and see if it makes sense. 
