


Punctuations: Learning Objective





monthly rainfall and annual unemployment rates etc.

Encourage your child to prepare a table for numbers of study hours every week and construct the line graph for the same. Ask them to suggest ways to show increase.

Encourage your child to measure items you find at home, using a centimetre-millimetre ruler. If the item is not exactly as long as the markers on the ruler, choose the nearest mark.

Encourage the children to first see how many whole centimetres long the line is. Then count how many little millimeter-lines beyond that it reaches e.g. A line is 2 cm 3 mm long. At the same time, it is 23 mm long. Why?

Discuss the number of kilometres travelled by you while going to work or supermarket and convert the same to meters and vice versa.
