




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Punctuation marks are used in writing.

- 1. The Full Stop (.)
- 2. The Question Mark (?)
- 3. Quotation Marks/Speech Marks (" ")
- 4. The Apostrophe (')
- 5. The <u>Comma</u> (,)
- **6.** The Exclamation Mark (!)



Punctuation: Pause while speaking to your child to enunciate the end of a sentence.

Encourage your child while reading a story to highlight punctuation marks-full stops, commas, question marks, exclamation marks, apostrophe and speech marks.

Grammar

Speak to your child and engage him/her to describe things around the house. Guide your child to use interesting vocabulary to describe the things around.

Encourage your child to annotate the Common nouns and Proper nouns found on the page of a story book.

Point out that pronouns avoid repetition.

Discuss the use of verbs in sentences. Write a sentence without verbs and ask your child to fill in the verb to complete the sentence.

Encourage your child to play this game. Place a pile of notecards with adverbs on them, as well as a pile of notecards with verbs on them. Have your child take turns picking a notecard from each pile and acting out the action that the








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Encourage your child to find time on a 12-hour digital clock and to the nearest five minutes on an analogue clock. Play "What Time Is It?" One member of the family is the town crier. He/she describes the time; e.g. "The hour hand is on the three, the minute hand is on the 2. What time is it?" Other members must guess the time.
