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


- To explore the idea of a significant author by collecting information on Michael Morpurgo and his style of writing.

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


Numeracy	<p>To round decimals with two decimal places to the nearest whole number and to one decimal place</p> <p>To understand percentage as the number of parts in every 100.</p> <p>To find percentage of numbers and quantities.</p> <div style="border: 1px solid black; padding: 5px; margin-top: 10px;"> <p>TIPS:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To find 10% divide the original number by 10. • To find 20% find 10% and double it. • To find 50% halve it. • To find 25% halve it, and halve it again Or you can divide by 4. • To find 5% find 10% and halve it. • To find 1% divide by 100. </div>	<p>Share with your child that to round a number to the nearest tenth , look at the next place value to the right (the hundredths). If it's 44 or less, just remove all the digits to the right. If it's 55 or greater, add 11 to the digit in the tenths place, and then remove all the digits to the right.</p> <p>To round a number to the nearest hundredth, look at the next place value to the right (the thousandths this time). Same deal: If it's 44 or less, just remove all the digits to the right. If it's 55 or greater, add 11 to the digit in the hundredths place, and then remove all the digits to the right.</p> <p>Share with your child that A percentage is just a fraction out of a hundred.</p> <p>Talk to the children that they can divide by 10 in order to find 10% of a quantity, and use this to find 20%, 5% etc. of numbers your child to calculate the percentage of each ingredient used in the recipe of their favourite dish.
