
Identify, describe the properties of 2-D shapes and find more than one line symmetry.

Encourage your child to identify lines of symmetry in 2D shapes presented in different orientations. He/she should know that some **shapes have more than one line of symmetry**. Ask him/her to look at these regular shapes and think about how many lines of symmetry they can find. Again, it is helpful for them to cut out the shapes and fold them in half, then look at how many folds they have made.








Identify, describe the properties of 3-D shapes

Talk to your child that 3-D shapes are made up of faces, edges and vertices.

At home or at a supermarket ask your child to point at a shape that has more than 6 edges, a shape that has a circular face, a shape that has only three faces, etc.

Properties of 3D shapes

Understand that halving is the inverse of doubling and derive and recall doubles of all numbers to 20, and the corresponding halves.

Encourage your child to find double of a given number by counting a set of objects or by using the rule of adding the same number to itself e.g.7+7=14

#### Science

To identify that most living things live in places to which they are suited and are called habitats.

To describe how different habitats, provide for the basic needs of different kinds of animals and plants, and how they depend on one another.

To explore different habitats such as desert, Aquatic, Forest and Arctic.

To identify that most living things live in places to which they are suited are called habitats and explain how different Minibeasts adapt to a habitat.

To analyze the ways animals, adapt to their habitats in order to more effectively catch food, stay safe from predators, and care for their young. Going on a treasure hunt

**Talk** to your child about the different places where they see animals and plants living. How do plants and animals survive in any habitat (place).

**Talk** to your child about the different habitats in the world such as desert, forest, minibeasts.

**Share** with your child pictures of different habitats or ask them to use the internet to find out more about different habitats. (Give clues – vegetation – types of trees, animals, climate etc.)

**Ask** children to think of any other ways in which animals might be dependent on plants?

**Encourage** children to write down all their findings and make a booklet on habitats.

Share with children examples of plants and birds cohabiting. Eg. Birds nesting in trees or bushes, squirrels living in trees, owls nesting in holes in trees, butterflies laying their eggs on plants etc. Plants can provide shade and/ or protection from heavy rain as well as shelter from animals.

**Share** with your child magazines and newspaper cuttings where there is information on pollution which causes damages in different habitats.

**Encourage:** Children to research more on different types of habitats using ICT and to prepare a power point presentation on it.


**Share** with your child the differences in firefighters' skills and equipment in the 17th century which might have affected the fire that happened in 1666.
