Topic: Percentages

Learning Objectives:

- Understanding and using percentages
- Interpret percentages as a fraction or a decimal, interpret these multiplicatively

- Talk to your child regarding Percentages which provides a useful and common way to express a part of a quantity. The word is derived from the Latin per centum meaning "by the hundred".
- Encourage them to collect examples from newspapers, magazines or from daily life related to common percentages such as 50%, 25% and 10% and practise estimating percentages to get a better understanding of the concept.

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TOPIC – Interaction of organisms in the environment

LEARNING OBJECTIVES-

- Evaluate the importance of predators in an environment and link it to changes in a food web.
- Analyze an example of interdependence of organisms in an ecosystem – for example, the effects of the destruction of rainforests.
- Analyze and evaluate the factors affecting endangered species and recommend solutions.
- Explain how energy flows through a food web.
- Compare examples of interdependence of organisms in an ecosystem – for example through symbiosis, commensalism and parasitism.
- Analyze and interpret some ways in which organisms affect, and are affected by, their environment – for example, predator–prey relationships.

- Motivate students to create a model demonstrating interaction of organisms in an ecosystem.
- Encourage students to work individually to create an analogy using Glogster, which explains examples of symbiosis and parasitism.
- Motivate students to make an infographic poster to present any survey conducted on how human activities have disturbed the interaction of organism in any ecosystem.
- Motivate students to create an interesting PowerPoint or otherwise visually appealing presentation to Describe an example of interdependence of organisms in an ecosystem using a food web
