- To write a book review for the novel.


**Ask** your child to express their enjoyment. What did they like and dislike about the book? Try to think of two or three examples of things that they liked and two or three examples of things they didn't like.




Your child could even like to give the book a rating e.g. how many stars out of five would you give for the book?
