



To interpret and present data using bar charts.

Pictograph

Talk: -Pictographs are charts that are used to represent data using icons and images relevant to the data. A key is often included in a pictograph that indicates what each icon or image represents. Let us understand the concept of pictographs using examples.

Share: -A survey was conducted for 40 children by a fastfood junction to understand the demand for different flavours of pizza available in their outlet. The results were as follows:

Talk: -A Bar Graph (also called Bar Chart) is a graphical display of data using bars of different heights It is a really good way to show relative sizes:

We can see which types of movies are most liked, and which are least liked, at a glance.



To explore the Water cycle.

To compare the processes of sublimation and evaporation.

Talk about the fact that some solids, when heated change directly into gas and that's called sublimation. Example: dry ice.

Share the uses of sublimation in real life. Examples: decorating apparel, signs, and banners, as well as novelty items such as cell phone covers, plaques, coffee mugs, and other items with sublimation-friendly surfaces.


Encourage them to explore in detail the process of sublimation.

Talk about the importance of the Water cycle.

Share how there is dew formation on the cars during the night, ask them to relate it to any other situations, like – ice cream or juice cans removed from the fridge and left out for some time have water droplets.
