To use tenses appropriately to show the timing of the action.

To explore explanation texts.

Letter Writing:

To use sentences of varied structure to write a letter.

Talk: Together with your child, explore a range of explanation texts and elicit the difference between these and other texts your child has learnt.

Share: Show your child a flow diagram and ask your child to explain it. For example the function of an eye.

Encourage: Encourage your child to use appropriate vocabulary and time connectives. It is imperative that your child uses complete sentences and correct grammatical syntax as this will ensure quality in the writing tasks.

Old-fashioned letter writing is a great way for kids to build their writing skills and practice their handwriting.

Here are some favorite letter writing prompts for kids to get started

- Write a letter to your friend describing what you've been doing at home or school.
- Write a letter to your teacher about your favorite game and why you like to play the game.

Being responsible is a key to children's success both in school and in the larger world when they grow up. **Share** your expectations with your child and **talk** about their responsibilities. **Encourage** your child to take ownership.



Pose a problem such as, "Annie has 11 crayons. She gets 18 more. How many crayons does she have in all?" Help your child understand the question by highlighting important information, then make a plan to solve, and then follow that plan. **Encourage** your child to check his or her answer. Repeat the activity again using other word problems that involve different operations.

Materials

To investigate the properties of different objects on the basis of the materials used.



To examine and explain how the shapes of some solid materials can be changed by applying a force.

To investigate how different materials can twist and stretch.

Share the properties of each material used to make the object and create questions based on properties to be able to play the quiz with you or friends.

Talk about the reasons for using the materials to make the object.

Conduct some fun experiments with your child.

Conclusion: Explain your findings.


