To use terms 'fiction' and 'nonfiction', noting some of their differing features,

e.g. layout, titles, contents page, use of pictures, labelled diagrams. To understand the features and characteristics of a simple report.

**ENCOURAGE** your child to collect information from computers, laptops, I pads etc..... and write a report about UAE or your home country.

Remind them to use typical report characteristics: a title, subheadings, descriptive information sentences, use of topic- specific vocabulary, and labels and captions.

### Rhymes and poems

To read a variety of poems.

To compare and contrast preferences in poems.

To use poems or parts of poems as models for own writing, e.g. by substituting words or elaborating on the text

Read a poem to your child. **ENCOURAGE** your child to shout stop when they hear a pair of rhyming words. Each time your child shouts stop talk about the rhyming words they have identified.

Write a rhyming sentence. Read it together and identify the pair of rhyming words. Underline the end sound in each word and **SHARE** that these letters produce the same sound in each word - that is why they rhyme. Write 'cat in the flat'. Read together; identify the pair of rhyming words.

**ENCOURAGE** your child to identify letters that produce the same sound in each word (at) and underline them. Explain that he/she will need to think of pairs of rhyming words to use in a phrase, so that rhyming poem can be created. The rhyming phrase needs to include an animal, like the examples you have looked at together as a class. Show some examples: dog in the bog; horse in the gorse; bear at the fair; snake in the lake; bat on the hat

## Numeracy

# Topics based on GAP Analysis Term 3:

To estimate, measure and compare weight using uniform, nonstandard units of measurement.

To describe position, direction and movement, including whole, half, quarter and three-quarter turns.

To solve problems involving money.

Talk: After shopping in the supermarket, talk to your child about checking the weight labels and ask him/her how to weigh the fruits and vegetables. Ask your child to compare and estimate the weight of items you have purchased. E.g.: Are the apples heavier than the lemons? How many cubes heavy are the apples?


**Encourage** your child to show time after taking quarter turn. Example: If the time is 12 O'clock what will the time be after taking a quarter turn? What will the big minutes hand point to? Ask if the time is half past 4 now, after taking three-quarter turns where will the big minutes hand point to?

Challenge your child by asking further if we take three quarter turns anti-clockwise now then where will be the big minutes hand point to?

Draw any object or letter and then check/record their positions after taking a whole, a half, a quarter or a three-quarter turn clockwise and anti-clockwise.

**Encourage** your child to buy grocery with you and read the price tags. Let them make a list of 6 things they need to buy from the supermarket and pick up those items in a trolley. Later let them add the amount and find out the total cost and the change they will get from AED 100.

# Revisit of topics from Term1 and Term 2

To read and show time in hour and half.

Share with your child what you can do, in half an hour or in one hour during the day. Using a homemade/toy clock, show the time at 3 O'clock and half past 3. Can your child now tell you where the hour (small) hand will point and where the minute (big) hand will point at half past 7? Repeat with different times. Discuss that half past 7 can also be written as 7:30. Talk to them about the difference between an analog and digital clock.

#### Science

To gatner and record data to help in answering questions.

**EXPLORE, RESEARCH** and **SHARE** information on changes across seasons.

Let the child describe seasons with the appropriate changes in weather.

**ENCOURAGE** your child to describe how day length varies in different seasons.

**ENCOURAGE** your child to **TALK** about How do the changing seasons affect us. What do we feel like. Is it light or dark outside when we get up and when we get home from school?

**EXPLORE** different changes during different seasons like color of the leaves, type of tree/flowers and record.
