Grammar

- **Speak** to your child and engage him/her to describe things around the house. Guide your child to use interesting vocabulary to describe the things around.
- **Encourage** your child to play this game.

Place a pile of notecards with adverbs on them, as well as a pile of notecards with verbs on them. Have your child take turns picking a notecard from each pile and acting out the action that the cards show.

For example, if the cards are "walk" and "stealthily," your child might tiptoe carefully around the room, looking around to make sure she's not being followed.

To explore rhyme schemes and create rhyming poems.

- Talk to your child about rhyming words.
- Read a poem to the child and let your child tell you the rhyming words.
- **Discuss** that a rhyming couplet is a pair of successive lines that rhyme. It's usually the last words at the end of each line that rhyme. They're also typically the same length and have the same meter or rhythm.
- **Encourage** your child to add rhyming couplets to the end of a rhyming poem.





Revision Lesson - Plants

- To explore the requirements of plants for life and growth (air, light, water, nutrients from soil, and room to grow), and how they vary from plant to plant.
- To explore the part that flowers play in the life cycle of flowering plants, including pollination, seed formation and seed dispersal.

Share with your child the different ways in which seeds are carried to different places (agents of seed dispersal-insects, wind, water, air).
