





Area of learning	Focus	Home activities - help your child at home.	Useful websites
Literacy	<b>Spelling</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>To use phonic knowledge to spell 'words ending with 'ore' and 'v' sound</li></ul> <p>Example – ore – shore, core, more etc..</p> <p>v – cave, have, olive, hive etc..</p> <b>Grammar</b> <b>Punctuation</b> <p>To use capital letters for I and names of people, animals or a place</p>	<p>Fold three columns on a piece of paper, and label one column 'trace', the next 'copy' and the last 'recall'. Write the word in the first column, and have your child trace the letters. Next have your child copy the word by looking at what he /she's just written. Finally, have your child fold (and hide) the first two columns and recall the spelling of the word independently.</p> <p>Jumble up all the words in a sentence excluding the punctuation.</p> <p><b>ENCOURAGE</b> your child to rearrange the words to frame a correct sentence and punctuate appropriately. Have a short conversation each day by taking turns to TALK with punctuation. E.g. Say....</p> <p>How are you today? Question mark. The child replies....'I am fine". 	<p>suffixes: -es- ing</p> <p>Prefixes -re</p>	<p>A suffix is something that we add to the end of a word that changes its meaning.</p> <p>Let's read these words together:</p> <p>Talk – talking, walk - walking, sing – singing How is the second word different? What has been added?</p> <p>Talk to your child ask What did you notice about the words? They are all things you can do. These 'doing' words are called verbs. They describe an action. Can you think of any more 'doing' words?</p> <p>A prefix is a sound or group of letters that attach to the front of a root word, for example, 'un' or 're' What does a prefix do? A prefix changes the meaning of the root word. What is a root word? A root word is a basic word, from which other words are made, when prefixes and suffixes are added.</p>	
<b>Numeracy</b>	To describe position, direction and movement, including whole, half, quarter and three-quarter turns.	Relate whole, half, quarter and three- quarter turns to reading time. Make your own clock using paper plate or use a toy clock. Show an hour takes a whole turn and half an hour take half a turn. Now challenge your child by asking questions like It is 3 O' clock. What will be the time half an hour later? Will the minute hand take a whole turn or half turn? Encourage your child to show the time after	 <p>I recognise quarter turns.</p>


To sort objects and answer questions from tables / lists, block graphs/ pictograms etc.



taking quarter turn by asking if the time is 12 O'clock what will the time after taking quarter turn and three-quarter turns.

### Challenge time

- A pattern is made by turning the turtle a quarter turn in each box. What will the turtle look like in the last box?



Talk to your child about how to go about making a weekly shopping list and sort the things in a table, block graph or pictogram as fruits, vegetables, tissue boxes, stationary etc. Let them find out the least and the most purchased group of items.


