Present Perfect Tense

Encourage conversations with your child, focusing on events or actions that have happened recently. Ask questions like, "Have you ever visited that place?" or "What have you done today?" Point out present perfect tense sentences in books, movies, or everyday situations. Discuss how they express actions that began in the past and have relevance to the present.

Prepositions


Encourage your child to describe things around the house with respect to their positions. Encourage them to use interesting and varied vocabulary to describe the position of the things around. Example: The flowers are in the vase. I left my shoes under the brown table.

Encourage your child to identify characters, settings, dialogues and main events.

Discuss the characters, their feelings, different settings and the plot of the stories.

Enact stories using puppets or through role play. **Encourage** your child to discern the main ideas in the text and to ignore irrelevant information.

Guide your child to narrate the most important details of a text they have read.

Talk to your child about rhyming words. **Read** a poem to the child and let your child tell you the rhyming words.


