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Numeracy

Number- Place Value:

To read and write numbers up to 1000.

To partition three-digit numbers into multiples of 100, 10 and 1 in different ways.

To compare and order numbers up to 1000.

To count on and back in steps of 2, 3, 4, 5 and 10.

To round the 2-digit and 3-digit numbers to nearest 10 and 100.

Encourage them to write number name against numbers for their age. E.g. I am eight years old Or My father will turn thirty-seven next month.

Similar, number related questions can be asked to challenge them.

Talk to children how partitioning numbers makes calculation quicker.

$$346 = 300 + 46$$

 $300 + 40 + 6$
 $300 + 30 + 16$
 $200 + 120 + 26$


Encourage them to skip count up to 100 and back to reinforce their number knowledge. Make it challenging by starting with a random number e.g. 51,61


To subtract two digit and three-digit numbers. To attempt one step and two step word problems.

Inverse Operation (Addition and Subtraction)


To recognize and use inverse relationship between addition and subtraction and use this to check calculations.


