

he/she has read it before/seen the film/ Together make predictions of what could the story be? **Discuss** the use of language by the author and check children's understanding of the language. **Ask** questions with reference to the text.

STREAM BASED ACTIVITY: Make a model of Willy Wonka's chocolate factory using recycled material.

**Talk** about the characters portrayed in the novel. Discuss the way the author has presented this character: Looks at some of the words/phrases that the authors have used to describe Charlie's feelings and senses as he waits outside the famous chocolate factory. Model how to turn these into similes and full sentences.

Types of Stories Genre: Introduce your child to classic fiction/novels like Charlie and Chocolate Factory. Discuss the setting, characters, plot, and author's use of descriptive language.




To read and write Roman Numbers up to 100.

**Talk** to your child about the history of numbers and Roman Numbers. Tell them that the numeral system changed to include the concept of zero and place value. Ask them to observe the numbers written in some wall clocks.

**Share** how different roman numbers look like and how a very large number is written using one symbol and a small number is written using many symbols.

**Encourage** your child to find the fun facts and rules of writing roman numbers.


