English	Spelling To use phonic knowledge to spell 'words ending with 'au'/aw sound and 'ou'/'ow' sound	Fold three columns on a piece of paper, and label one column 'trace', the next 'copy' and the last 'recall'. Write the word in the first column, and have your child trace the letters. Next have your child copy the word by looking at what he /she's just written. 	Grammar Compound Noun	Compound Nouns are nouns that are made with two or more words. They are usually formed by noun + noun or adjective + noun. Example – lunch + box = lunchbox, foot+ ball = football. Activity - Give your child a jumbled-up list of compound and non-compound words. Then have them decide which is which. This is a great way to show your child the difference between the words, allowing them to recognise compound words within sentences.
