Informal Letters:

To write different variations of letters e.g. – informal, invitation letter, thank you, response etc. Guide your child to look for vocabulary and find the meanings as well as the synonyms and antonyms in a dictionary.


Talk about the book cover and blurb and let your child predict what the novel is about.




