Again, it is helpful for them to cut out the shapes and fold them in half, then look at how many folds they have made.



Science	Identify that most living things live in places to which they are suited and are called habitats.	Going on a treasure hunt Talk to your child about the different places where they see animals and plants living. How do plants and animals survive in any habitat (place). Talk to your child about the different habitats in the world such as desert, forest, minibeasts. Share with your child pictures of different habitats or ask them to use the internet to find out more about different habitats. (Give clues – vegetation – types of trees, animals, climate etc.)	Different habitats









	 Describe how different habitats provide for the basic needs of different kinds of animals and plants, and how they depend on one another. To explore different habitats such as desert, Aquatic, Forest and Arctic. To identify that most living things live in places to which they are suited are called habitats and explain how different Minibeasts adapt to a habitat. Analyze the ways animals adapt to their habitats in order to more effectively catch food, stay safe from predators, and care for their young. 	Ask children to think of any other ways in which animals might be dependent on plants? Encourage children to write down all their findings and make a booklet on habitats. Share with children examples of plants and birds co-habiting. Eg Birds nesting in trees or bushes, squirrels living in trees, owls nesting in holes in trees, butterflies laying their eggs on plants etc. Plants can provide shade and/ or protection from heavy rain as well as shelter from animals. Share with your child magazines and newspaper cuttings where there is information on pollution which causes damages in different habitats. 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Physical Education

Body balance workout:

During BODYBALANCE the focus is on improving functional core strength, enhancing joint mobility and creating a sense of wellbeing and calm, not calorie-burn.

Strength workout:

Strength exercise, or resistance training, works your muscles by using resistance, like your own body weight. This type of exercise increases lean muscle mass, which is particularly important for weight loss, because lean muscle burns more calories than other types of tissue.

Flexibility workout:

To improve mobility, posture, muscle

- Hopping
- Walking on the straight line.
- Hold the body in T position.
