#### How to use summarising

Begin by reading let your child listen to the text selection.

Ask your child to answer these questions:

What are the main ideas?

What are the important details necessary for supporting the ideas?

What information is irrelevant or unnecessary? Which are the key words or phrases connected to the main points from the text
