

- To explore figurative language and use them in creating their own poem.



**Discuss** conjunctions and the importance of using them in writing. **Encourage** them to use them while speaking and creating sentences. **Ask** them the purpose of each type.

**Encourage** children to use fronted adverbials in their written work by demonstrating how a sentence they have written could have been changed by putting the adverbial at the front.

Children might be given pieces of card with different parts of a sentence written on them, so that they can experiment with the different ways the

sentence could be put together.

It can also be a helpful exercise to give children a word mat of adverbials which are divided into different topics, and then ask them to use this to complete unfinished sentences. For example:




