

EDUCATIONAL PROVISION

- Until September 30, our parents will have the choice of distance learning or face-to-face learning for their children. Students will attend face to face on site lessons at school, these lessons will be simultaneously live streamed those who opted for distance learning in the month of September
- From October 3rd 2021, all teaching and learning will be face-to-face only. After this date, students who wish to continue with distance learning must provide a medical certificate issued by Dubai Health Authority.
- All lesson are paced for 50 mins. There are 6 lessons per day, after registration there are 3 lessons followed by break and then the next 3 lessons.





EDUCATIONAL PROVISION

- Students will be given a designated chair and table and no swapping among students is allowed.
- For specialist classes students will be moving between the classes but the classroom will be sanitized after use for every group of students.
- Students must bring their own exclusive stationery items, fully charged devices or gadgets(i.e. laptops, tablets and headphones).
- All assignments and work will continue digitally. Teachers will continue to provide reading or review materials and use digital tools/apps to encourage paperless work.





SCHOOL ENTRY PROCEDURES

- Vaccination is not mandatory for students in Dubai.
- Only one family member is allowed for pick-up or drop-off inside the school. However to drop your ward inside the school you must carry your vaccination card or PCR test result taken within 48 hours.
- Parents can access the school for school tours, fees payment, provided they have been vaccinated or have a valid negative PCR test result taken within 48 hrs.
- Thermal screening will continue for own transport and Bus users. Anyone with a temperature of more than 37.5 degree Celsius will not be allowed entry.
- Students above older than 6 years of age are required to wear face masks at all times.





ENTERING THE SCHOOL

School will start for all students at 7:50am.

DROP OFF:

- Parents will drop their child at the main entrance.
- Any conversations with the staff members at this time will not be possible.
- Please note the students cannot enter the premises before 7.15 am.





EXITING THE SCHOOL

- Dispersal will be staggered for different year groups to facilitate social distancing and to eliminate overcrowding.
- The bus students will exit from the classroom first at 2 pm, after a 15 mins gap the own transport students are expected to move towards the allotted area.
- All secondary students including those with siblings in the primary will wait in basket ball court or the AstroTurf year wise designated areas to be picked up by their parents entering from gate number 1 and will exit from gate number 2.
- All students who are walking or cycling home will disperse at 2:15 pm after picking up their younger siblings from designated pick up point.



EXITING THE SCHOOL

- Gate 1 will open only after all buses leave by 2:20 pm only.

 Parents are requested to avoid queuing outside the gates.
- Parents using their own vehicle can drive through and enter from Gate 1 and collect their child and exit through Gate 2 ONLY. Please do remind your child of your car model, colour and number for quick and smooth exits.
- Students who use public transport, bicycle, walking can exit from Gate 3, front of the school
- OT pass sample can be downloaded from the link given in the cover letter sent along with the Welcome pack.
- ALL students not using BUS must carry the OT pass duly filled and signed by the parents.

HYGIENE

- Hand sanitizers are placed in every class.
- Effective sanitization post completion of each day will be conducted and cleaning process will be in-line with Dubai Municipality guidelines for school
- Families are encouraged to supply food and beverages for their children along with their own plastic safe utensils. Teachers will supervise so that children do not share food.
- Adequate hand washing breaks for children will be encouraged under adult supervision to maintain the hygiene standards.





IF YOUR CHILD BECOMES SICK AT SCHOOL

- Students with regular ailments will be sent to school clinic where the doctor will assess and treat them accordingly.
- Students with suspected COVID symptoms will be sent directly to the isolation room where they will be monitored by a nurse/doctor.
- If the student is stable then parents will be contacted for pick up within 30 to 45 minutes maximum.
- If the student is not stable, ambulance will be called to shift to the hospital accompanied by parent or an adult from the school if parents are not available.



- The medical team will follow up with parents to collect the PCR results.
 - If tested negative and has no symptoms he/she can return to school with a Covid-19 negative test result.
 - If tested positive, he/she must home quarantine for 14 days and return to school upon providing negative test result only.
- All in close contact with confirmed COVID positive patient will be notified by emails or calls and must undergo home quarantine for 14 days.
- Those in close contact are not required to get tested if they are asymptomatic.



IF YOUR CHILD BECOMES SICK AT SCHOOL-continued...

- Symptomatic close contacts of confirmed cases and those who are at higher risks of developing respiratory symptoms should be tested for PCR.
- The school will not administer any medicines to your child.
- If your child tests positive for COVID-19, you are mandated to inform the school so that they can take measures to secure the health of other students and staff who may have been exposed to the virus.
- Information about your child will not be shared with anyone other than the relevant government authorities.
- Deep disinfection process will be initiated to all the areas exposed.



NON NEGOTIABLES TO PROTECT THE COMMUNITY

- Kindly ensure your child carries extra mask ,sanitizer and antiviral wipes.
- The student must wear mask at all times and maintain safe distance of recommended 1m in all common areas.
- Do not send your ward to school if he/she is sick. Notify the form tutor and we shall support in the educational provision.
- Talk to your child on the importance of wearing mask and sanitizing hands frequently.
- Vaccinate your child if possible to provide the required immunity.

LOCKERS

Students will be provided with lockers and the details of the same will be shared with you through a circular soon.





BREAK TIME

- During the break time, the protocol recommends students to go out.
 However we shall have staggered break and the details of this will be shared with students by their form tutor.
- They can remove their masks while eating.
- Students are recommended to carry a packed lunch and enough water.
- School is not permitted to sell hot meals on the premises. Parent will have to preorder packaged food online which will be delivered to the students in their respective classes. The water coolers/dispensers will not be operational.
- There are two mobile canteens and students can buy food or water if needed.
- Sharing of food and water with peers and friends is not permitted.
- Students must ensure not to litter the classroom and keep their classrooms clean at all times.





EVENTS AND PHYSICAL EDUCATION

- Performances, events, celebrations are allowed while maintaining health and safety standards.
- Extra curricular activities and school trips will resume based on the guidelines issued.
- During PE lessons, students and teachers will not be required to wear face masks when engaged in strenuous physical activities such as running and workouts, as long as they adhere to physical distancing measures.
- Frequent sanitization of all equipment, and all areas in which PE lessons are offered will take place to maintain health and safety standards.





TRANSPORTATION

- Buses will resume operation at 100% capacity.
- Anyone entering the bus should undergo temperature screening and if the temperature is more than 37.5 degree Celsius, the student will not be allowed in the bus.
- All bus riders, with the exception of children younger than 6 years need to wear masks.
- Daily record keeping will be maintained by capturing all bus riders throughout the daily transportation program/trips. Absence shall also be recorded.





TRANSPORT SAFETY MEASURES

- Children will be assigned seats on the bus for the entire term. They must sit in their designated seats only.
- The seats, handrails etc. will be sanitized after every use.
- Further guidelines and policies will be shared by STS.

COMMUNICATION

- Meetings are encouraged to take place only online, unless there is a critical need for a face to face meeting which should take place on an appointment by email basis and will need to be made and approved beforehand.
- We will stay in close contact with you. This will be through our website, elearning platform, calls, online meetings, webinars, online orientation workshops, online assemblies, weekly updates and emails. Please ensure you know what group your child is in.
- **Emails** -Teachers will get back to you within 24 hours. Teachers are unable to reply to any emails during contact time
- ➤ If there is any urgent message, we request you to call the School reception and leave a message. The teacher will call you back during her non-contact time
- ➤ WIN Stronger Together —online Well-being platform for all stake holders to share concerns



COMMUNICATION

- We will stay in close contact with you before and after reopening. This will be through our website, e-learning platform, calls, online meetings, webinars, online orientation workshops, online assemblies, weekly newsletters, textmessage updates or emails.
- Meetings are encouraged to take place online, unless there is a critical need for one to one meeting which should take place on an appointment by emai basis and will need to be made and approved beforehand. This will be in a different allocated conference room which will be disinfected and sanitized after every meeting and all meetings will be kept to maximum of 20 mins, maintaining social distance.
- Parents can meet Registration/ Accounts /STS /PRE/GRE after 2:30 pm or through prior appointments only.





COMMUNICATION

- We are initiating an online Well-being platform for all stake holders to share concerns with SLT every Tuesday from 3 to 4 pm called WIN Stronger Together.
- Parents are requested not to come to school for early departures or change bus departure to Own Transport suddenly as we will not have staff to fetch students or deliver short notice messages. All such communication should be shared a day before with the respective form tutor/ STS team.
- Schools are mandated to inform you in case your child may have been exposed to a positive case of COVID-19 while at school.





BYOD-Bring Your Own Device Policy

- Students must bring their devices for online interactive learning and to research
- Students are responsible for their own devices. School will not be responsible for any loss or damage.
- Devices must be used in the lessons only when instructed by the teacher.
- Taking photographs/videos/recordings of fellow students and teachers is strictly prohibited and will incur sanctions as per school policy.
- We also create awareness on Cyber safety to help our students to make right choices and to be safe online





BYOD- Bring Your Own Device Policy

- Posting unwanted/derogatory comments/photographs/Videos about students/teachers and the school on social websites Facebook/Whatsapp/Snapchat/Twitter etc.
- Resorting to any kind of bullying in school or from home digitally will be considered as Cyber bullying and will incur sanctions as per school policy.
- Students are not permitted to use MOBILE PHONES during the school hours.
- This will enable focused learning in lessons as well as a safe and supportive social and digital environment.
- They will be required to register their device with the school IT system and access internet only through the school WIFI which is controlled and monitored for safe and appropriate use.



BOOKS AND DEVICES

- As per the KHDA Protocol 82, Unnecessary material, like carpets, equipment and furniture should be removed from classrooms
- Physical textbooks will be used by students. They will bring as per the timetable as directed by the teacher.
- Students from YEAR 3 onwards must bring their own fully charged devices to school equipped with MS office tools. Mobile phones are not permitted in school.
- Data packages are also not permitted for online safety control.





ATTENDANCE AND PUNCTUALITY

Attendance is directly related to performance and progress.

- > To ensure your child's attainment and progress, it is imperative that your child maintains a healthy attendance record.
- ➤ The latest your child should arrive by is 7:50 am in school. The school gate closes by 7:55 am. Any child arriving after 8 am receives a late slip.
- ➤ If your child is absent, for any reason, please email the teachers before 7.45am even if you have opted for Distance Learning.
- > Students who have opted for Distance Learning must log by 8:15 am.
- ➤ After 3 late slips you will be required to have a meeting with HOY and HOK






