

# Type of School Model and Student Groups

At The Winchester School, we are offering a blended learning model with combination of face to face lessons at school and live streamed lessons at home as per the time table. Some parents have opted for 100% Distance Learning. Based on their preference, students have been divided as follows:

- o Blended learning and has been assigned to Group A
- Blended learning and has been assigned to Group B
- 100% distance learning Group

**BLENDED LEARNING Group A** will come to school for face to face learning on Sunday, Monday and Tuesday in Week 1 and on Wednesday and Thursday in Week 2 and will access live streaming of lessons on the remaining days of the week as per the time table.

**BLENDED LEARNING Group B** will come to school for face to face learning on Wednesday and Thursday in Week 1 and on Sunday, Monday and Tuesday in Week 2 and will access live streaming of lessons on the remaining days of the week as per the time table.

**100% Distance Learning Group** will access the live streaming of lessons simultaneously through the online e-learning platform from home as per the time table.

Kindly ensure your child attends school only on the days mentioned below. We will not be able to accommodate your child on other days since we cannot mix the groupings as per the directives laid by KHDA. In such a case your child will be sent back home.

#### i. Uniform:

For face to face learning at school, students need to be in proper school uniform. On the days they have PE, they need to wear PE uniform only.

For online learning (including those opting for 100% distance learning), students need to be dressed in smart casuals (need not wear the uniform), be awake on time and prepared for lessons as per the time table.

### ii. Attendance:

Attendance will be monitored for face to face as well as online learning. Absence will be followed up.

# iii. Availability of recorded lessons:

The recordings of all the live streamed lessons (other than PE) will be uploaded on the elearning platform. There will also be some pre-recorded

Younger students who cannot access devices independently as both parents are working during the day, or for other students who have not been able to attend the lessons as per the time table due to connectivity/device concerns or not being well, must attend the recordings of the lessons and submit the required assignments as per the timelines. They must inform the form tutor and /or subject teacher via email if they are not able to attend lessons as per the time table.

#### iv. Resources needed:

All students must be equipped with resources required for their lessons. They must have their own devices compatible with MS office tools.

# v. Textbooks and notebooks:

The circular about textbooks, notebooks and stationary will be sent soon. There is a delay in the shipment of textbooks.

This will not impact learning as teachers will be sharing all resources needed for the lessons and the first two weeks will focus on settling in, sharing and embedding expectations and revisiting key concepts from last year.
