The Winchester School aspires of very high educational standards achievements. We have embraced the UAE National agenda targets and continue the strive for ensuring Winchester students exceed set targets.

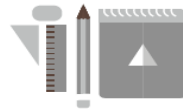
At the beginning of 2014, H.H. Sheikh Mohammed Bin Rashid Al Maktoum launched the UAE National Agenda, which includes a set of educational development in the UAE. The educational targets cover a wide range of areas affecting the quality of education and student achievement across the different phases. Two of the major targets are concerned with the UAE ranking in PISA (Programme for International Student Assessment) and in TIMSS (Trends in International Mathematics and Science Study).



PISA (Programme for International Student Assessment) is a triennial international survey which aims to evaluate education systems worldwide by testing the skills and knowledge of 15-year-old students. **TIMSS** (Trends in International Mathematics and Science Study), for the past 20 years has measured trends in Mathematics and Science achievement at Year 5 and 9 respectively. It is conducted on a regular 4-year cycle. **The UAE aims to be among the 20 highest performing countries in PISA and among the 15 highest performing countries in TIMSS.**



PISA: to be among the 20 highest performing countries in PISA



TIMSS: to be among the 15 highest performing countries in TIMSS



Completion of high school education: to ensure that 98% of Emirati students complete their high school education



Attending pre-primary: to ensure that 95% of children in the UAE attend pre-primary education



High skills in Arabic language: to ensure that 90% of Grade 9 students develop high skills in Arabic language in the UAE NAP assessment



Highly-quality teachers: to ensure that 100% of schools have high-quality teachers



Highly-effective school leadership: to ensure that 100% of public schools have highly-effective school leadership



University foundation programme: to ensure that no students need to join the university foundation programme.

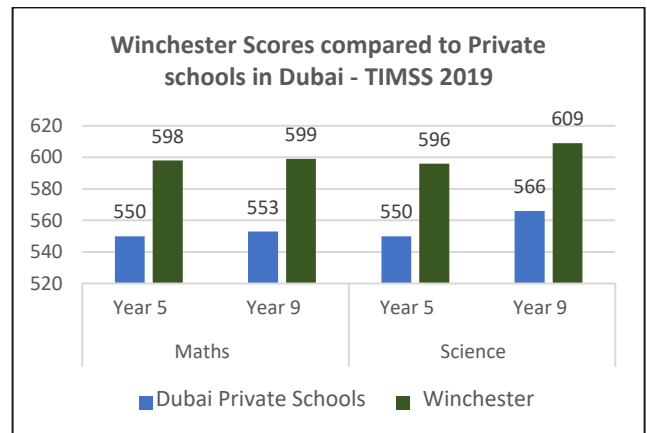

Trends in International Mathematics and Science Study

WINCHESTER's Outstanding Performance in TIMSS in 2019. We are elated that in both Year 5 and Year 9 Science, we have exceeded the average score of the top performing country – Singapore as well as that of the outstanding schools in Dubai. In Maths, we are at 4th position in Year 9 and 5th position in Year 5 compared to average scores of countries worldwide and ahead of average scores of outstanding schools in Dubai.

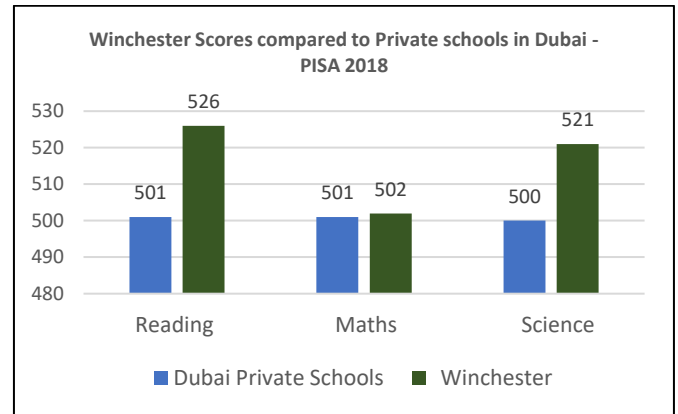
